

Children in Chino Valley are going Hungry.

The statistics are startling:

- ⇒ Of the 2,444 students registered in Chino Valley Schools last year 1,475 students qualified for reduced or free lunches.
- ⇒ 2010 Census shows the Chino Valley poverty level at 19%.
- ⇒ Chino Valley Schools have over 140 students who meet the Federal Government's definition of 'homeless youth'. These are students living in shelters, cars, motels, or sharing housing with others due to loss of their own home or economic hardships.
- ⇒ Mingus Charter School was added in 2014-2015. Registered students 184. We feed 27 of them.

Chino Valley students affected by this receive reduced or free lunches and free breakfasts during school and summer vacations. However, over the weekend, the students may lack adequate food and may spend their weekends hungry.

The 'No More Hungry Kids Project' was introduced in the Prescott/Humboldt area to address the same need. Five years later, the program has proven to be very successful.

Chino Valley successfully finished our 4th year, 2015-2016, with the program feeding 185 kids per week.

A Solution

The Chino Valley Family Church in partnership with Sodexo and Chino Valley Schools brought the project to Chino Valley to address the needs of children within our community.

Starting August 11, 2016 the program will feed about 185 children each weekend throughout the school year. Students will be given a bag containing a variety of non-perishable food items. The average cost per bag is \$6.00 The goal is to serve all of the students who need to receive a bag of food for the weekend. Bag deliveries are done confidentially to the students through school health offices.
