Children in Chino Valley are Going Hungry.

The statistics are startling:

- ⇒ Of the 2,450 students registered in Chino Valley Schools over 1,500 students qualify for reduced or free lunches.
- ⇒ 2015 Census shows the Chino Valley poverty level at 27%.
- ⇒ Chino Valley Schools have over 250 students who meet the Federal Government's definition of 'homeless youth'. These are students living in cars, motels, or sharing housing with others due to loss of their own home or economic hardships.
- ⇒ Mingus Charter School was added in 2014-2015. Registered students 184. We feed 33 of them.

Chino Valley students affected by this receive reduced or free lunches and free breakfasts during school and summer vacations. However, over the weekend, the students may lack adequate food and may spend their weekends hungry.

The 'No More Hungry Kids Project' was introduced in the Quad City area in 2011. Seven years later, the program has proven to be very successful.

A Solution

The Chino Valley Education Foundation - Hungry Kids Project's mission is to eliminate a common barrier that affects attendance, retention and academic achievement of the students in Chino Valley by providing food to those students.

Last year (2017-2018) the program fed about 245 children each weekend throughout the school year. Students were given a bag containing a variety of mostly non-perishable food items. The average cost per bag was \$7.00

We are currently meeting our goal to serve all of the students who need to receive a bag of food for the weekend. Bag deliveries are done confidentially to the students through school health offices.
